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## Challenge 3 – Race Across the World (in 10 Days)

You have a travel budget of £1500. Your challenge is to plan an epic journey through at least six different countries, but you're not allowed to fly at any point! Use your geography, budgeting, and research skills to create the ultimate travel adventure.

### The rules:

-  Flights are banned – only use trains, coaches, ferries, bikes, or your feet!
-  Accommodation and transport must all be included in your budget
-  You must travel through at least 6 different countries
-  You cannot spend more than £1500 in total
-  Your journey must last between 7 and 10 days
-  You must stay at least one night in 3 different countries
-  Start from your nearest UK town or city (you do not have to get back there!)
